2017/2018 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Objective: The value and cost of a post-secondary education has increased considerably. This program seeks to offset some of those costs by providing scholarships in any chosen field to qualified members or the child or legal dependent of a member of VEA.

Six Educational Scholarships

Two (2) VEA *full time academic* scholarships

- \$1,000/per year/per student for four (4) consecutive years
- Open to qualified high school seniors

Two (2) VEA *full time vocational/technical* scholarships

- \$1,000/per year/per award for two (2) consecutive years
- Open to entire membership

Two (2) VEA *part time continuing education* scholarships

- \$500/per year/per award for one (1) year
- Open to entire membership

Award winners will be introduced at the annual meeting on Saturday, April 28, 2017.

Eligibility and Application Requirements

At the time of the application and award the applicant must be:

- member of Valley Electric Association
- or the child or legal dependent of a member of VEA

Applicant must complete and submit the attached scholarship application in full, including all required attachments. They must arrive no later than:

5:00 P.M., FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2018

Please note:

- These scholarships are not transferable
- Recipients will be notified early April of 2018
- Recipients must agree to personally accept the initial award of the scholarship at the 2018 VEA Annual Meeting on Saturday, April 28, 2018
- VEA will select award recipients based on the specific scholarship criteria
- Scholarship awards will be sent to the recipient upon the successful completion of each semester or quarter of part time continuing education or academic and technical study carrying a full course load.

For Academic Scholarship winners, they must present a transcript showing completion for 4 plus courses (12 hours) with a minimum of a C grade average, and proof of class registration for the next semester.

For Continuing Ed Scholarship winners, they must present a document showing successful completion.
